Step One

Step 1 and Step 2 can be done in any order.

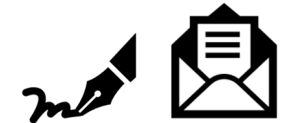
Step Two

Person taking consent phones the potential participant to explain the study and answer any questions.



Step Three

Study participant signs the consent form and posts it back to the hospital, along with the HAQ and EQ5D



Top Tips!

- 1.If you don't have a DAS-28 for when the participant started therapy, use the closest pre-biologic score from the patient notes.
- 2.If you need stamps for postage, contact the team and we can send you some.
3. There is also an outreach consent process for re-registering people already on the study – contact us for this on the address below.
